The Prince's Trust TEAM programme is a 12 week personal development programme for young people aged 16 to 25.

The programme consists of:

Team building

Weeks 1 and 2 are all about getting to know each other, including a team building outward bound residential.

Community Project

In weeks 3, 4, 5, and 6 you will fundraise for, organise and work on a project for the community.

Employability Skills

In week 7 we will help you write your CV, practice interview skills and look for employment/education.

Individual Work Experience

In weeks 8 and 9 you will attend a 2 week work experience of your choosing. Previous work experience has included M&S, the Zoo and the Nike Store.

Event planning and hosting activities within your local community

In weeks 10 and 11 you will fundraise, organise and deliver a final team challenge for a local community group.

Final presentation

In the last week you will celebrate your achievements in a black tie presentation evening and give a speech to your family and friends.



The Prince's Trust Team Programme, delivered by Cheshire Fire and Rescue Service (CFRS) is designed to develop your skills, self confidence and motivation.

Gaining recognised qualifications will help you to gain employment or enter into further education. This is at no cost to you.

Join a team of about 15 people of similar age, both unemployed and employed. Spend 12 weeks having fun, making new friends, helping the community and the environment.

During the course you will take part in team building activities, fund raising, work experience and a residential week.
