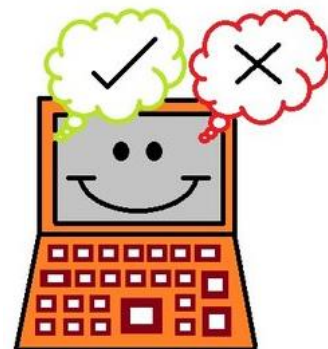


# Understanding cyber behaviours

## AIMS

1. To profile individuals with good cyber skills on:
  - Cyber abilities, autism traits, support available from others (e.g., family, friends)
2. To understand why people choose to behave legally or illegally online

## METHOD

- Questionnaire based survey.
- Assessing ability, autistic traits, interpersonal support, digital skills & reasons for choosing to behave legally or illegally online.
- Approximately 30 minutes to complete.

## YOU CAN TAKE PART IF YOU:

- Are 16 years or older.
- Have a good understanding of English.
- Have good cyber skills (e.g., scripting languages, hacking).
- Don't have untreated epilepsy, psychosis or head injury.

- To help inform recruitment strategies.
- To help prevent people from getting in trouble with the law.
