**CWP's Autism Spectrum Disorder Assessment and Diagnostic Service** 

NHS **Cheshire and Wirral** Partnership **NHS Foundation Trust** 

A locally contracted and managed diagnostic service for adults who may have Autism Spectrum Disorder across Cheshire and Wirral, who do not meet the threshold for community learning disability services.

#### The Service offers:

- \* A co-produced assessment format
- \* A NICE compliant Multi -disciplinary assessment including Occupational Therapy & Psychiatry.
- \* More than a yes/no assessment report- ie, whatever the opinion, helpful advice on what it means to the person & their supporter's.
- \* Clear recommendations on the application of reasonable adjustments, how to maximise the person's strengths, address their needs & support them in achieving their aspirations.
- \* Appointments in every CCG locality
- \* Centralised information, advice and support to wider CWP services to maximise the engagement of autistic adults and the outcomes of any interventions.

Referrals accepted directly from a GP or any CWP service. Acceptance criteria:

- Adults aged 18+ Wirral and East Cheshire CCGs (16+ for West Cheshire, South Cheshire and Vale Royal CCGs)
- Adults who score 6 or above on an initial self- assessment screening tool (AQ10) and where traits appear to be longstanding.
