Requirements:

- Male and Female aged between 16 to 80 years old
- Available for at least two days of filming as per the above dates and times
- Posing as university students and members of university faculty.
- Required Clothing: 1960's style clothing and accessories is required for the duration of the shoot (see inspiration mood boards below). The clothing must be provided by the extras themselves. The production team is not able to provide wardrobe/clothing to the extras.


