






Question:


Did a member of Space4Autism staff encourage or support you to attend a social club?

Question:


Did you find the process of registering to attend a social club straightforward?

Do you feel welcome and included?






Do you agree with this statement? I am able to suggest new ideas and suggestions for future sessions and feel I am listened to and my views are considered.

More trips out – **we do try to include as many trips as possible funding wise and not too many as the numbers can be restricted.**
